# Internal Security Concerns Regarding the MEK and Resistance Units

## Introduction

This analytical report is based on an investigation of a collection of secret-classified documents, including audio clips and written minutes from the "Security Council of Tehran and Alborz Provinces." The timeframe of these documents spans from 2020 to 2025.

The Tehran Provincial Security Council is one of the most vital security structures, responsible for coordinating all intelligence, military, and law enforcement agencies in the capital. Within the country's security hierarchy, it holds a key position (following the Supreme National Security Council and the National Security Council). Access to the proceedings of this council—which typically meets bi-weekly with the Governor of Tehran and senior security, intelligence, and police officials—is of strategic importance.

The very fact that the People's Mojahedin Organization of Iran (PMOI/MEK) has accessed such a volume of classified information and the extraction of audio files and written transcripts from meetings held under the strictest security protocols indicates an active infiltration network and MEK access within Iran to sensitive layers of the regime's administrative and security structure.

## The Role of Organized Combat Forces in Iran

One of the main questions often asked is whether it is possible for the Iranian people to overthrow this regime. It is argued that the IRGC is strong and will suppress any movement that threatens the regime's survival. It is further argued that there is no organized force inside Iran capable of effectively confronting the IRGC.

It is important to recognize that the path to overthrowing the regime in Iran is not a single-variable question; it involves multiple factors. The military dimension is only one of these factors. Therefore, viewing regime change solely through a military lens leads to miscalculation. By that logic, no dictators would ever have been removed from power. In addition to the polycrisis the regime is facing and the growing popular discontent—which together form the bedrock for regime change—there exists in Iran an organized force with combat capability. The effectiveness of this organized force must be understood within this broader context. It is the combination of popular uprising and an organized force within Iran with combat capability that brings about regime change. While the IRGC and the regime as a whole may be more resilient against a foreign power, no matter how brutal they are, they are far more vulnerable when facing such a combined force.

The activities of the Resistance Units over the past few years have increased both in quantity and quality. These Resistance Units have become more organized and are working more coherently, effectively functioning as a liberation army within Iran. On 23 February 2026, in the heart of Tehran, 250 members of these Resistance Units carried out a joint operation targeting Khamenei's compound—the most secure location in the country—and confronted the security apparatus there. The PMOI/MEK subsequently released the names of 82 combatants who were either arrested or killed during the confrontation, but the regime has refused to hand over their bodies or acknowledge their arrest.

## Duality of Approach: External Propaganda vs. Internal Concerns

Reviewing the past six years reveals a glaring contradiction between the regime's media stance and its internal security assessments. While official government rhetoric and propaganda outlets consistently attempt to "deny," "downplay," or portray the role of Resistance Units as "ineffectual," the Security Council documents reflect a different reality. In these meetings, the activities of Resistance Units are discussed not as a marginal issue, but as one of the primary and ongoing security challenges. This contrast demonstrates that the regime's media silence is not due to the weakness of the opposition, but is a political tactic to manage public opinion.

## Operational Dimensions and Field Tactics

The reports in question illuminate details of the Resistance Units' field performance that are significant for analysts:

- \* **Resistance Units at the Forefront of Security Concerns:** According to the top secret internal documents, the activities of Resistance Units over the past six years have been a constant and frequent focus of Security Council meetings. Security officials have continuously discussed their actions, organizational methods, and countermeasures. This persistence shows that the issue is not merely a series of scattered events but is viewed as a structural and enduring phenomenon in the regime's security assessments.
- \* **Continuity of Activity Under Suppression:** The most striking aspect of these reports is the persistence of these units over many years. The documents show that despite the focus of intelligence agencies on arresting and dismantling teams, this network has been able to repair losses through "rapid reconstruction" and "personnel replacement." The ability to shift operations from one province to another indicates a dynamic and flexible structure.
- \* **Breaking the Atmosphere of Repression:** The documents frequently reference actions aimed at countering the atmosphere of fear. A major theme is the Resistance Units' reactions to waves of executions. While the regime uses execution as a tool for social control, security reports state that Resistance Units have attempted to reduce the deterrent effect of this tool and break the "wall of fear" through responsive operations.
- \* **Role in Sparking and Sustaining Uprisings:** Reports submitted to the Security Council highlight the role of Resistance Units in laying the groundwork for protests and popular uprisings. Officials emphasize that these units keep the atmosphere of protest alive through field actions and symbolic operations. For external analysts, this indicates that protests in Iran are not merely spontaneous social reactions but involve organized networks that play a role in their continuity and direction.
- \* **Innovation in Tools and Operational Methods:** Another segment of the discussions is dedicated to the innovative tactics used by Resistance Units. There are references to the arming of some teams and the use of creative methods to build equipment. For example, reports mention the construction of simple launchers using plastic (PVC) pipes, which security officials admit have been effective in certain operations. This reflects a shift toward low-cost but effective "asymmetric" tactics.

## Prediction and Emergence of Strategic Threats

The alignment of intelligence warnings with subsequent events demonstrates the security apparatus's inability to counter the strategic threats posed by the Resistance Units. In a report from 2023, the head of the Tehran Intelligence Organization—referring to the arrest of an operational team—disclosed the discovery of a coordinated six-pronged attack plan on the "Beit-e Rahbari" (The Supreme Leader's residence/office) and concluded that this is a serious priority for the MEK.

This security assessment was eventually realized on February 23, 2026, when Resistance Units consisting of 250 organized members launched a heavy assault on Khamenei's residence. The execution of this operation, just five days before foreign intervention and the death of Ali Khamenei, confirmed the Security Council's prior reports regarding the high operational capacity and will of the Resistance Units to target the most sensitive centers of power in Iran.

A statistical overview of the activities of the Resistance Units in the Iranian year (March 2025-2026).

- 1,404 anti-repression operations
- 10,333 other anti-government actions
- 630 operations involving clashes with the regime's repressive forces during January uprising
- During the uprising, 2,000 Resistance members were arrested or killed, yet their activities intensified.

## Excerpt from the 28th Tehran Provincial Security Council Meeting (February 18, 2020):

Over the past few days in the month of Bahman [January/February], several disruptive acts took place within the jurisdiction of the District 10 Revolutionary Court on Jihoon Street, the Martyrs Foundation, the facilities of the Headquarters for Executing the Order of the Imam (EIKO), and the Ministry of Interior. Following investigations, the perpetrators responsible for the [incident at the] Jihoon prosecutor's office were identified and arrested. Images of their activities were discovered at their hideout, and several explosive fuses and materials for manufacturing improvised explosive devices (IEDs) were seized. One of these individuals has a record of six years in prison for ties to the Monafeqin<sup>1</sup> [MEK], while the other individual had no prior criminal record.

Based on a 100% assessment by the Tazirat [security/punitive authorities], these two individuals are responsible for the other actions as well. They have not yet confessed. Regarding the incident in front of the Ministry of Interior—although it was not very significant—they recorded and distributed footage of it. Following investigations, this act has been attributed to the MEK. Their operational style does not match the subjects [monitored individuals] currently under our surveillance; they appear to have been brought in from other provinces.

Regarding the Martyrs Foundation, we have a series of leads that are not yet fully developed. The suspects are among the residents of West Tehran. Their mode of operation and choice of targets indicate a high level of local knowledge in the area. God willing, we will achieve favorable results.

## Excerpt from the 16th Tehran Provincial Security Council Meeting (November 25, 2020):

Within the provincial intelligence community—noting that part of this also operates at the national level—the primary issue at the top of the agenda is the "Hypocrisy" group [a pejorative for the MEK/PMOI]. Regarding their activities over the past two years, we have addressed approximately 144 cases. These generally concern their Resistance Units, with a significant portion involving "hard" [violent] operations. This marks a shift in their strategy toward an escalation of violent measures involving military-grade weapons.

The most recent case we acted upon took place in Tehran and along the Sistan route. Part of this investigation remains active. For the first time since the early 1980s, the "Hypocrisy" group has turned toward shoulder-fired weapons and the procurement of RPGs. They had identified three targets in Tehran for operations in November [the month of Aban]: the Revolutionary Court, the National Cyberspace Council, and Press TV. The arrested operative confessed to targeting all three locations, as well as an attack carried out this past October [the month of Mehr] against the Intelligence Directorate and the IRGC headquarters in Isfahan.

Overall, operations against the group clearly indicate that, based on numerous messages relayed through their coordinators [contacts], they have moved toward quasi-armed activities and are currently escalating. They had only used shoulder-fired weapons once before, in the early 1980s, in an attack on "Agha Mohsen's" [Mohsen Rezaei] office—located in what is now the Ministry—targeting our command headquarters. Following that period, they used long-barreled weapons [rifles], but such activity eventually ceased until this year, when they reverted to this approach.

Furthermore, they are actively seeking to acquire drones and have prioritized the production of improvised mortars. They have already conducted training for this; we have discovered prototypes and seized improvised mortars. This is a critical issue that demands everyone's attention, as it poses a significant threat.

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<sup>1</sup> Monafeqin (hypocrites) is a derogatory term used by the regime to refer to the PMOI/MEK, implying that they are not Muslims but merely claim to be.

## Excerpt from the 16th Tehran Provincial Security Council Meeting (June 16, 2021):

**Reyhani (Head of Tehran Intelligence):** We are on the eve of June 20 [the anniversary of the start of the MEK's armed struggle]. The MEK views this as a security milestone which necessitates special monitoring.

The strategy announced within the framework of the 'Fifth Founders' involves armed actions through "contact points" into the country; they are seeking to incite unrest and have put all their energy into this; it is highly likely that the layers they have armed will move toward violent armed work; consequently, we must preempt any situation that trends toward crisis and disorder."

## Excerpt from the 27th Tehran Provincial Security Council Meeting (February 23, 2022):

**Security Assessment:** Intensification of recruitment by the MEK inside the country, especially in Tehran. Their strategy regarding Resistance Units is the formation of "one thousand units."

In January 2022, there were 91 recorded propaganda and disruptive actions by the MEK in Tehran province (12 disruptive, 79 propaganda). This included broadcasting "structure-breaking" (anti-regime) slogans via audio systems in Tajrish, Varamin, and Shahriar.

## Excerpt from the Secret Audio Document of the Alborz Provincial Security Council (September 26, 2022):

**Naeimi (Head of Alborz Intelligence):** Regarding the MEK, they have sent organizational instructions to their internal elements. First, they ordered the burning of sites, similar to 2009. They said "the fire must never leave the streets."

They have specifically emphasized targeting law enforcement forces because they are the first line of confrontation. They instructed members to carry backpacks, water, incendiary materials, self-defense tools, lighters, gasoline, hooded jackets, and nail clippers—the latter for cutting plastic zip-tie handcuffs. If our colleagues in the police find these items during arrests, they should know it follows the MEK line, , and addressing it is a necessity in the specialized field of interrogation.

Their next agenda is the disarmament of officers, bases, and police stations; specifically, they have prioritized both the arming of their own elements and the disarmament of our personnel. Thanks to the foresight and measures taken by my dear brothers in both the IRGC (Sepah) and the Law Enforcement Force (NAJA), fortunately, we have no forces present in gatherings equipped with firearms or even cold weapons. However, protecting police stations and bases is an absolute necessity. While this has certainly been attended to until now, from today onwards, even greater vigilance and scrutiny are required. I am certain that my dear brothers have the necessary strategies in place regarding this matter.

## Part of a Secret Audio Document: 18th Meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council- October 30, 2023

With the permission of the honorable Governor, we begin the 18th session of the Security Branch. Given that we have set our time from 6:00 to 8:00 AM, and following the points raised by colleagues in the previous session, we intend to cover the agenda items very concisely.

At 7:30 AM, per the resolution of the previous meeting, we have invited several officials from the Tehran Province Telecommunications Company to provide explanations regarding the continuous and repeated strikes and protests occurring within the telecommunications sector.

First on the agenda, we have a report from the Tharallah Headquarters. Mr. Sadat, Honorable Advisor to the Governor and Director General, will briefly present the reports prepared by the Assessment Commission.

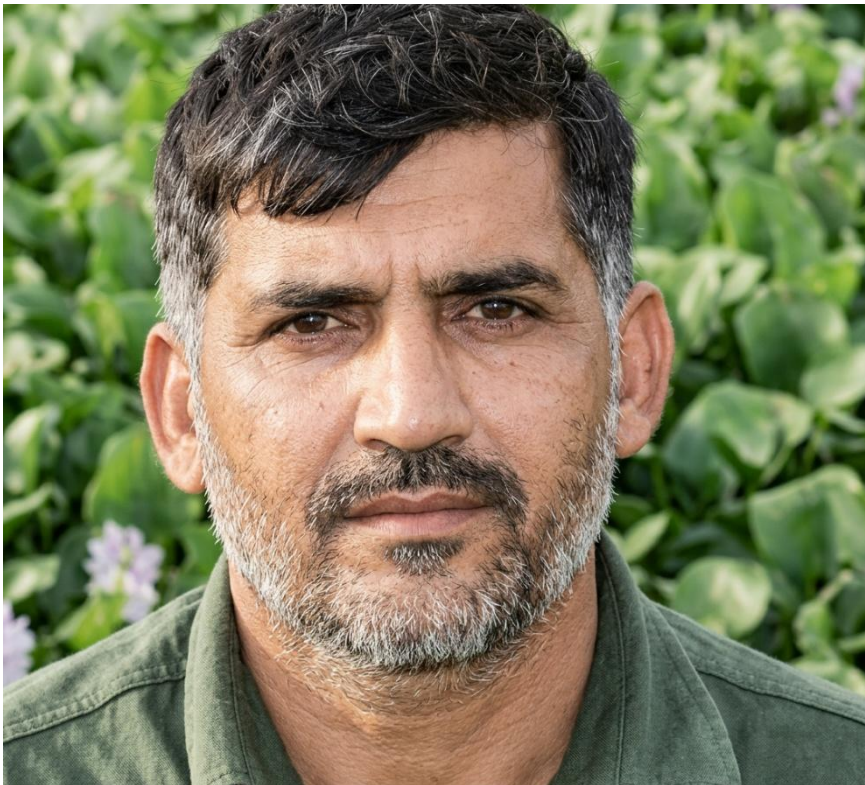
**Kamal Sadat, Secretary of the Tehran Provincial Security Council:**



The "Hypocrites" [MEK] have introduced a messaging app called "Element" to replace Telegram, WhatsApp, etc. It is unfiltered, untraceable, and its primary features include the ability to delete information instantly and en masse.

There have been calls to install remote "image-projection" devices to display the loathsome images of the leaders of the MEK without the need for a physical presence on-site.

**Mr. Beigi, Commander of the IRGC Intelligence Organization in Tehran Province:**



In the name of God, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. Greetings and respect to my colleagues; good morning. I have two or three brief reports to share.

The movements of the Hypocrites indicate they are expanding their plans. One of their objectives involves designing attacks on the primary centers of the Law Enforcement [Police] headquarters, as well as the command headquarters of the IRGC and the Basij.

Unfortunately, on October 21 at 2:00 AM, we again witnessed an explosive projectile launched via a handheld launcher. This was aimed at the Basij Organizations Building in Sepah Square, fired from the vicinity of the Sayyad Shirazi Highway. According to field investigations by our colleagues, two individuals were responsible. The incident occurred from the direction of Babakhanlu Street, behind the National Military Service Organization building. Fortunately, none of the projectiles hit the interior of the complex, but they caused the sound of explosions. The matter is currently under investigation.

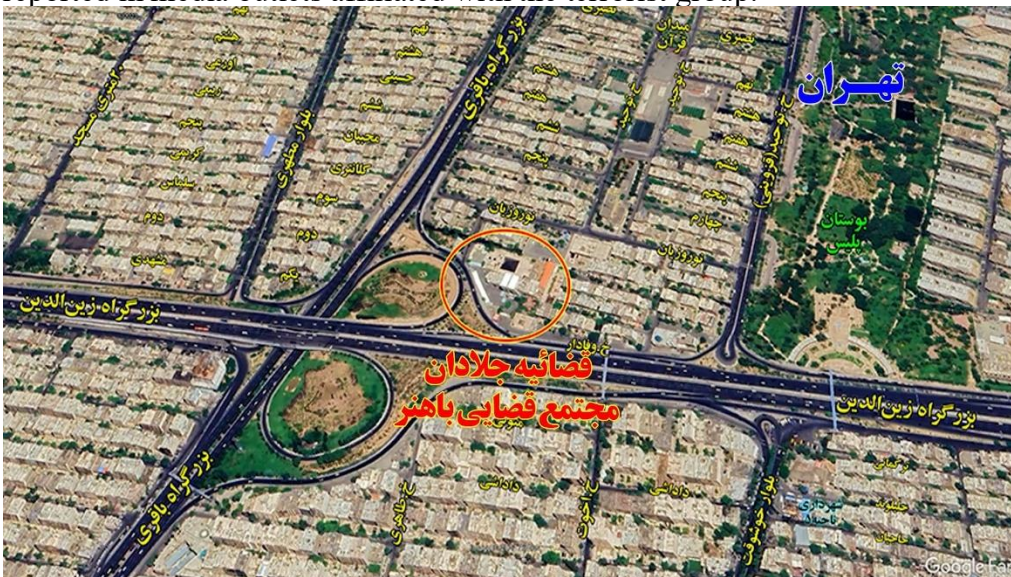
This session is for the review of the most important news and events in the province, as presented by our colleagues and representatives in the Intelligence Assessment Commission. Mr. Sadat will begin. [Salawat]

**Kamal Sadat, Director General of Security for Tehran Province:**



Greetings and respect to all distinguished colleagues. I present the highlights of the security and law enforcement reports regarding the actions of the "Monafeqin" [MEK] terrorist group:

The launching of explosive projectiles at the Shahid Bahonar Judicial Complex on October 28 was reported in media outlets affiliated with the terrorist group.





They claimed this action was in response to 16 executions carried out during the first four days of Aban (October 23–26), including six Baluch prisoners, intended to intimidate and prevent an uprising.

On November 2, two explosive packages were thrown at the District 10 Prosecutor's Office on Dampezeshki Street by an individual with a masked face.

Handmade firecrackers were thrown in front of the Tharallah Headquarters on the Niayesh Highway. Four individuals appeared at the entrance of the headquarters, shouting insults and slogans against the IRGC. They struck the entrance gate several times with machetes before fleeing.

Launching explosive projectiles at classified locations and reflecting these events in media outlets affiliated with the MEK remains a current agenda for this terrorist group. Therefore, identifying the key individuals involved in such actions is essential.

**Amir [High-ranking official]:**

In the name of God... Regarding the MEK, they are still waiting for an opportunity and seeking a major propaganda move to demonstrate that they hold the upper hand among anti-revolutionary and terrorist groups.

However, given their current potential, their actions are presently limited to "harassment" (diversionary) tactics. The operational line of the MEK currently involves identifying students—both university and high school—who were dealt with last year due to their roles in the riots [protests]. They are looking to identify, recruit, and employ these individuals.

## Excerpt from the Secret Audio Record of the 20th Meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – November 19, 2023

**Presiding Officer:** We are in the Security Council. With the permission of the honorable Governor and the honorable Chairman of the Tehran Provincial Security Council, we officially begin the 20th meeting of the Council. With your permission, the first item on the agenda is the presentation of intelligence updates... as raised by your honorable representatives in the various agencies. I invite Dr. Sadat, the honorable Director General of Security, to speak. Please proceed with a Salawat upon Muhammad and his progeny.

**Kamal Sadat (Director General of Security and Law Enforcement for Tehran Province):** Security and law enforcement: [We note] the focus of the Monafeqin [MEK] operational hubs on conducting disruptive actions. This includes training on the construction of pipe bombs, known as "three-way bombs," using flammable materials such as aluminum powder, minimum [red lead], and sulfur. There has been a call for 150 "fire-oriented" operations by the Resistance Units, targeting the Judiciary, the Governor's Office, district offices, mosques, military sites, banks, and so on. Awareness of the ongoing judicial proceedings has led the MEK to accelerate their activities, utilizing teenagers aged 14 to 17 to advance their goals.



## Excerpt from the Record of the 22nd Extraordinary Meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – December 13, 2023

**Abbasali Mohammadian (Commander of Greater Tehran Police - FATEB):**



One point I forgot to mention concerns projectile tools. I will bring these projectile tools and the launchers they are currently manufacturing to the meeting so that the colleagues can observe them up close. Each of these is made to launch a single round. These rounds are handmade and activated via a fuse. These tools have a specific design; it is not the case that a single launcher can fire multiple times—rather, each launcher is for one projectile. They are made of "Polica" [PVC] piping and operate with a fuse. Naturally, within the radius where these projectiles can reach their target—particularly from inside "Park-e Shahr"—we must maintain full security coverage.

**"Seyyed" (Representative of the Ministry of Intelligence):**

Another important point is that we are all prepared for the day of the court hearing and subsequent sessions. Our brothers in the military and the IRGC are present, as are our own colleagues. The sensitivity remains high during all nights before and after the court sessions. This is an ongoing process. We must remain vigilant regarding the perimeter of the court location. During the nights when we are not physically present, they may carry out "launcher" operations, as their routine is usually around 2:00 AM or 11:00 PM to midnight. We must cover these hours because they are conducting extensive psychological operations abroad. Thank God it has not had much reflection inside the country, but one of their propaganda lines is: "We hit the court venue and we will hit it again." In the coming days, we must be fully alert. God willing, we are at your service.

**Excerpt from the Secret Audio Record of the 24th Meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – December 31, 2023**

**Presiding Officer:** We are at the service of you esteemed and honorable gentlemen for the 24th meeting of the Provincial Security Council. The first agenda item is the presentation of...

**Kamal Sadat (Director General of Security and Law Enforcement, Tehran Governor's Office):**



Security and law enforcement news: Potential sabotage at the Karaj Dam power plant on December 19. Drinking water from the temporary dam was cut off; investigation revealed that during the water outage, the cameras and servers had been turned off.

Threats from the "Mary" network: An increase in numerous fires within the country's "Mary" network in recent days, including fires at the Mahshahr Petrochemical plant, Isfahan Oil Refinery, Kangan Petro-refinery, Birjand Refinery, and the Isfahan power plant turbines.

The activities of the Resistance Units and the so-called "Liberation Army" [NLA] have intensified, focusing on incendiary launches. Multiple strikes in the oil sector workers' network in the south of the country have been reported.

Cyberattacks against infrastructure by hacking groups have intensified, an example being the recent issue with the fuel system at gas stations.

Commander Vlaizadeh, please proceed:

**Brigadier General Valizadeh (Commander of Seyyed al-Shohada IRGC Corps):**



In the name of Allah, the Beneficent, the Merciful. I offer my greetings and respects to all colleagues. I thank everyone for the kindness shown toward this humble servant and for those who took the trouble to attend the (...) meeting. God willing, please pray for me to have a righteous end and to emerge proud and successful from this mission...

Another matter: Last night, IRGC Intelligence arrested an operational agent of the Nefaq [MEK] Resistance Units. This individual was involved in burning banners during Basij Week, an explosion in front of the Varamin Prosecutor's Office, and establishing contact with the Nefaq terrorist current abroad.

**\*\*Rastegar, Head of the Intelligence Organization of Tehran Province:\*\***

"Well, friends are aware that for about two years now, the law enforcement, judicial, and military apparatuses have been facing security disturbances from the \*Monafeqin\* [MEK] group. They have been carrying out nuisance operations using incendiary materials, destructive weapons, or launchers. Last year, the number of these incidents increased, and the level of harassment reached a point where the Commander of the IRGC, General Salami, personally ordered that this commotion be brought to an end.

Thankfully, last year, two launcher teams were identified and arrested in Tehran—one of them in Pardis. Following that operation and the eradication of those activities last year, we have witnessed the reconstruction and renovation of their operational teams again this year, as their numbers have increased. They have carried out approximately 20 operations against judicial complexes, military barracks, FARAJA [Police] headquarters, and unfortunately, even the Ministry of Intelligence.

By the grace of God, due to the intelligence oversight that exists, a launcher team that intended to strike a FARAJA headquarters using a new method was intercepted. They had connected their launchers in

series—placing them two by two—intending to fire in volleys of four. They were arrested before they could take action. A safe house [team house] was discovered, and currently, two of their other teams are under surveillance. A few days ago, one of their members was arrested, and they have another safe house that we are currently working on.

However, the key point is that these were all individuals who had been arrested in previous years. They belong to families of the \*MEK\* and some had been sentenced to [internal] exile. For instance, the guy was supposed to be in Kerman, but now he is in Tehran. Neither the Judiciary, nor the IRGC, nor the Intelligence Office in that location reported that these individuals had not arrived. This means that even when we exile them, the mechanism there does not realize they are absent to report that 'this person has gone missing.' He is in Tehran right now.

\*—Aren't they supposed to report every week?\*

Apparently, there is currently no accountability. He is supposed to be there [in Kerman]... but now he's in a safe house. He should be in Kerman, but he is in an operational cell. Some of them were previously imprisoned and some were even granted pardons by His Eminence [the Supreme Leader]. They received 15 million Tomans for each operation. We are building the case in a way that Mr. Ghana'at-kar's hands will be open to issue the death penalty for them this time, God willing, so that this whole affair can be finished once and for all."

### **Part of a secret audio document from the 25th meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – January 14, 2024**

"With the permission of the honorable Governor and the honorable Chairman of the Security Council, we begin the 25th session of the Security Council in the presence of you, dear colleagues. The second item on our agenda is the presentation and review of the most important news and specific events of the province, which Mr. Sadat will present."

**Kamal Sadat, Director General of Security and Law Enforcement for the Tehran Governor's Office:**



"The new tactic of the Monafiqeen [MEK] for carrying out terrorist actions involves overnight stays in guesthouses, renting houses and temporary workshops for three-month periods, the use of untraceable SIM cards, and the in-person purchase of specialized tools for handmade weapons from the Hasan Abad district."

## Part of a secret audio document from the 26th meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – January 28, 2024

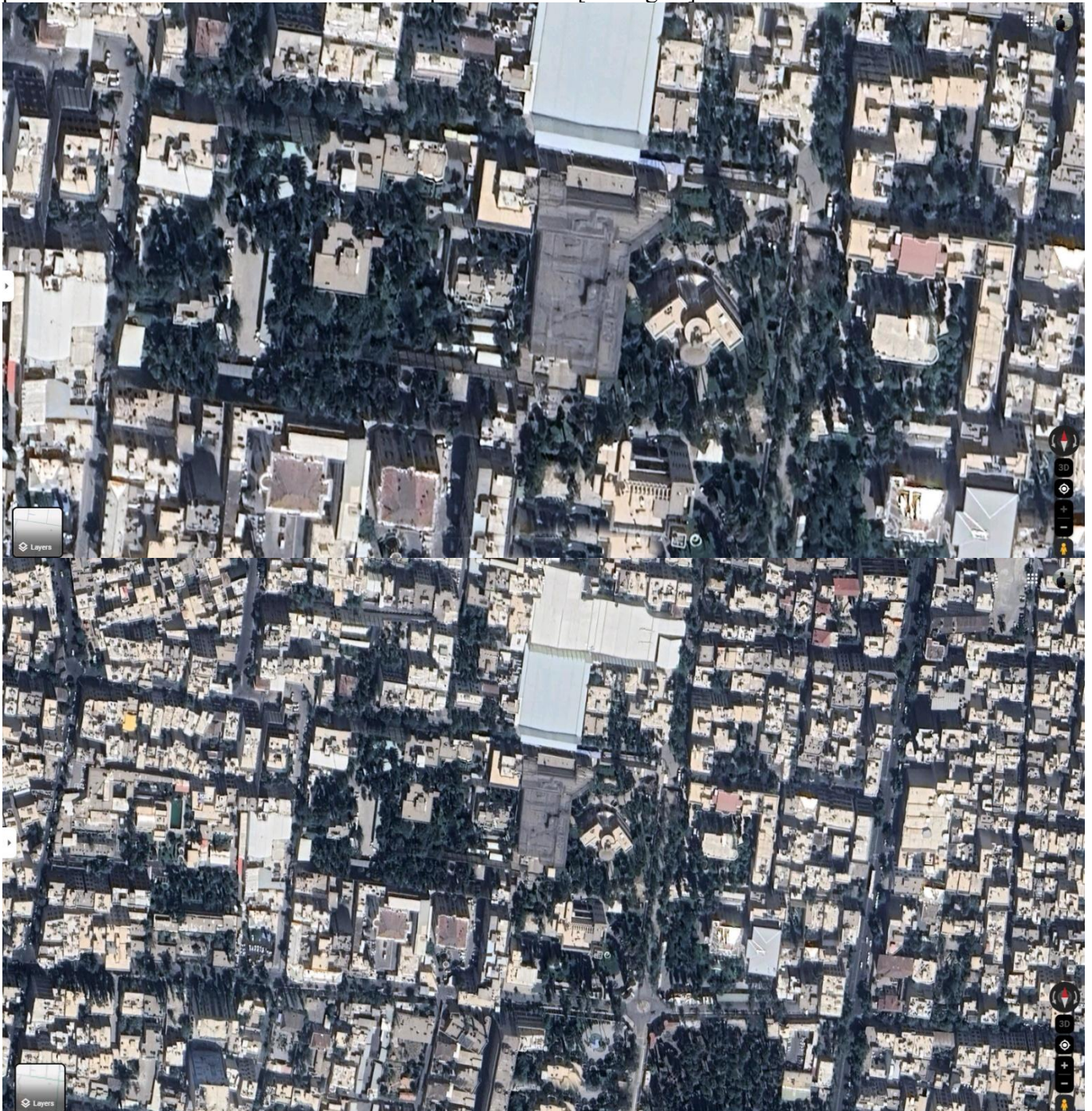
"Esteemed colleagues, we are at your service for the provincial security council meeting of the current [Persian] year. Thank you. Dr. Rastegar, please proceed..."

### **Rastegar, Head of the Tehran Intelligence Organization:**

"In the name of God, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. Greetings and respects to all esteemed superiors. Well, General [Sardar] Beigi..."

Friends have noted that we are unfortunately in a unique security situation. As for the MEK, their status is clear; following the recent blows they sustained, it hasn't even been a month and this 'launcher team' of theirs—which was a strong and capable team—has already been reconstituted as a new launcher team with plans to operate.

In the confessions of the previously arrested launcher team, for the first time, we found that they had planned an assault on the Office of the Supreme Leader [the 'Agha'] from six different points.



We have never seen this before. They had scouted and identified six locations where there are intelligence gaps and a lack of so-called law enforcement and physical oversight, and they intended to take action there.

Information had also been provided by the handler (Sar-pol). Since it is on the handler's agenda, these new teams may be capable of carrying this out."

### **Excerpt from the secret audio recording of the 27th meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – February 4, 2024**

[Speaker 1]:

Alright, we are at your service for the 27th meeting of the Security Council, held on an extraordinary basis. This is in light of our previous meeting, where all the distinguished attendees—particularly our honorable brother, General Beigi, and our colleagues in the Organization—emphasized the need for an extraordinary session due to the specific issues and unique threats surrounding the days leading up to the February 11th anniversary [22nd of Bahman] and the "Ten-Day Dawn" celebrations. We are at the service of our colleagues. Mr. Sadat will present the latest and most significant news reviewed by your representatives in the news assessment meeting. Afterward, God willing, we will defer to General Beigi and our colleagues in the Intelligence Organization for the latest information and reports regarding threats. Please start this part with a Salawat.

#### **Kamal Sadat (Director General of Security and Law Enforcement for the Tehran Governor's Office):**

Following the blow dealt to their previous "launcher team," the Monafeqin [MEK] group has once again formed a strong team for sabotage operations. Their planned actions include an assault on the Residence of the Supreme Leader and six other points where they have identified security gaps. [Other threats include] the intensification of Resistance Units activities through attacks on government and military premises, graffiti writing, destruction of religious and national symbols, and the burning of banners—specifically those of General Soleimani and banners bearing the images of the Supreme Leader (may his shadow endure) and Imam Khomeini (may God's mercy be upon him).

Furthermore, [threats include] the throwing of handmade grenades and Molotov cocktails, as well as bioterrorism threats given the placement of Salawati stations [charity refreshment booths] along the route. There is also the possibility of placing speakers or loudspeakers along the routes leading to Tehran University to broadcast speeches by the leaders of the MEK or to chant slogans against the system and the leadership with the aim of disrupting the order of the march.

### **Excerpt from a classified audio document of the 29th session of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – February 26, 2024**

#### **Seyed Kamal Sadat, Director General of Security and Law Enforcement for the Tehran Governorate:**

"I should report that hostile movements—including the Nifaq [MEK] and the 'People's Army' groups—continue to pursue their agenda through graffiti and the dissemination of hashtags such as 'My Vote is Overthrow,' 'No to Voting,' 'We Will Not Vote,' 'Finger in Blood,' 'Sham Elections,' and 'Boycott the Election Circus.'

Hostile media have launched a campaign titled 'Burning Posters and Campaign Banners' aimed at encouraging and inciting negative public sentiment and creating chaos and insecurity. They have called on the people to set fire to the posters and advertising banners of election candidates in public thoroughfares.











Furthermore, calls have been issued by hostile and counter-revolutionary elements to gather at the burial sites of those killed during the period of disturbances [protests]. In view of the upcoming Chaharshanbe

Suri (the last Wednesday of the year) festivities, the Monafeqin [MEK] terrorist group has issued a call in cyberspace titled the 'Wednesday of Fire' campaign.

This nationwide 'Wednesday of Fire' campaign—which I should mention begins on March 2nd, the day after the 'fake elections'—states: 'In memory of the martyrs, let us light fires in every alley and neighborhood, and crush the regime's centers of repression and plunder.'"

### **Part of a secret audio document from the 30th meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council, March 11, 2024.**

30th Meeting of the Security Council – March 11.

"With the permission of the honorable Governor and Chairman of the Security Council, the first item on our agenda is the review of the most significant news and events, which shall be presented to you by Mr. Sadat, the honorable Advisor to the Governor and the Provincial Director General of Security."

**Seyyed Kamal Sadat, Director General of Security and Law Enforcement for the Tehran Governorate:**



"Regarding the security threats and challenges associated with the last Wednesday of the year [Chaharshanbe Suri], I must report the following:

The launching of hashtags, challenges, and calls for action related to Chaharshanbe Suri, and the invitation of the public to participate in protests and street gatherings during these ceremonies. Attacks using Molotov cocktails and hand grenades against law enforcement forces and motorized or vehicle patrol units. Disruption of urban transportation by scattering caltrops [three-pronged spikes] on high-traffic thoroughfares.

The intensification of activities by Resistance Units and attacks on government and private premises, mosques, Hussainiyas, and other sites. The destruction and arson of ceremonial banners, monuments, urban surveillance cameras, signage, and government, private, and public property, including trees, trash bins, vehicles, and similar items.

The use of quadcopters and drones to drop explosive materials into power infrastructure or military, law enforcement, and government sites. The use of incendiary balloons, or the accidental or intentional burning of green spaces, pastures, parks, and areas with significant vegetation. The use of firearms and shooting at non-military individuals with the intent of projecting power and intimidating citizens. Calls for graffiti writing, distributing leaflets, chanting slogans from rooftops, or launching balloons containing anti-revolutionary messages."

### **Excerpt from the Secret Audio Transcript of the 11th Extraordinary Meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council- June 18, 2024**

Opening:

We have the news reports, which will be presented by our dear Mr. Sadat.

**Kamal Sadat, Director General of Security and Law Enforcement for the Tehran Governorate:**

Greetings and strength to all the dear colleagues. I will present the highlights of the news; you can see the PowerPoint. The People's Mojahedin Organization (the Monafegheen [Hypocrites]) intends to hold a rally titled "Free Iran World Summit" on June 29, 2024, which coincides with Tir 9, 1403, in Berlin, Germany. The call for this gathering has been welcomed by many political figures from hostile countries, as well as many members of Resistance Units inside our country.

Given that this date coincides with ceremonies such as the 40th-day memorial of the "Martyrs of Service" [Ebrahim Raisi and his entourage], the Eid al-Ghadir celebrations, and the presidential elections—and since members of the Resistance Units consistently engage in harassment operations against government, military, and religious sites prior to such summits—four such incidents have occurred over the past two weeks. Therefore, it is necessary to adopt preventive measures and arrangements. An assault on the Ministry of Interior building and the throwing of two Molotov cocktails at the building's stairwell was one of the actions taken by these Resistance Units...

**Amir Hariri, Army Intelligence Representative:**

In the name of God, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. I will speak very quickly and then hand the floor to one of our friends. We received a report that the MEK group, in line with its goal of creating polarization and inciting a sort of war between electoral groups and factions, has instructed its subordinate forces that on June 20 (30 Khordad)—which is tomorrow, yes, exactly the anniversary—there is a possibility they will attack [campaign] headquarters. They intend to frame other rivals for these attacks. Therefore, it is conceivable that this plan might take hold. Our friends responsible for supervising the campaign headquarters should be mindful of this issue so that, God forbid, no action is taken by this blind-hearted group.

**Brigadier General Alireza Fakhari, Governor of Tehran:**

To supplement the remarks of Mr. Amir Hariri, I should say: Well, regarding the anniversary of June 20, 1981 (30 Khordad 1360)—how many years has it been today? 43 years ago; it's entering the 44th year. That day, we were headed to the front; the Tehran IRGC was there on Kheradmand Street. We went to get our regional cards stamped. We were a bus of 40 people. It was a Thursday afternoon. They announced, "Go, a number of people have arrived who have been slashed, stabbed, and beaten with chains." These battered people had come toward the Iranshahr IRGC on Iranshahr Street. We asked, "What's happening?" They said, "Go look and see what is happening from Shahid Qareni Street to Ferdowsi Square and above."

We went and looked at Shahid Qareni Street. I think there were about seven or eight thousand people—both the MEK and leftist groups—who, from that day, declared armed war. From a day like tomorrow, they practically entered the military phase. Oppositional groups, especially the MEK and the Communists, moved into this issue starting tomorrow... regardless, we got involved and arrested about five or six hundred of them and sent them to Evin [Prison], and the rest dispersed.

From that day onward, the issue of street clashes in Tehran took shape with greater intensity. That is to say, there wasn't a day in Tehran where we weren't directly engaged in armed conflict with the MEK and the Fedaiyan-e Khalq guerrilla groups in seven, eight, or ten different spots. That memory remains. Therefore, tomorrow is a sensitive day for them. The timing is also sensitive, and they may likely put serious harassment operations on the agenda from tonight until tomorrow. We must be very vigilant regarding these matters. I wanted to review the historical background of June 20 once.

**Excerpt from the Classified Audio Document of the 17th Meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council-August 12, 2024**

Opening:

With the permission of the honorable Governor and the honorable Chairman of the Security Council, I open the 17th meeting of the Security Council for the year 1403 [2024].

**Rastegar, Head of the Tehran Intelligence Organization:**

Regarding the two operational actions mentioned by Sardar Hassanzadeh—harassing actions carried out by Resistance Units over the past week, specifically from last Friday until now—two incidents have occurred. One, as I report to you, was against the Headquarters for the Promotion of Virtue and Prevention of Vice in Tehran Province, located in the Pasdaran district.



Two Molotov cocktails were thrown at the site; one ignited, while the other failed to function. It is a bit suspicious, and we are currently following up through the Prosecutor's Office. The second case involved the building of the Provincial Department of Culture and Islamic Guidance in Sa'adat Abad. In that instance, an incendiary-sonic device was thrown, resulting in both an explosion and a fire. These two incidents occurred last week.



Given the upcoming Arbaeen period, we identified an operational team linked to an overseas handler (sar-pol) in District 20. Since Sardar Hassanzadeh specifically highlighted District 20, I should mention that we had two Resistance Units completely under our intelligence surveillance. They were connected to a handler outside the country. Due to the sensitivity and importance of the Arbaeen ceremonies in District 20, and based on a judicial warrant, we acted within 15-5 because they were truly dangerous.

Thus far, they have confessed to six actions: one against the South Tehran Tax Office, one against a branch of Bank Saderat, and the burning of at least four FARAJA [Police] vehicles that I had noted down. Additionally, a portion of the extensive graffiti [anti-government slogans] in various areas—specifically in the northern districts of Tehran—was the work of this same team.

This is a three-person team. Following the martyrdom of [President] Raisi, the third individual was seeking to acquire weapons and had successfully obtained one firearm. Due to the sensitivity we felt, particularly regarding District 20 and the Arbaeen ceremonies, we struck them. Another team is also ready [for arrest], and God willing, we will move against them as well. I believe that on the eve of the Arbaeen period, our colleagues in the Ministry [of Intelligence], the IRGC, and the Law Enforcement

(Entezami) must strike any operational cases we have so that we can successfully reduce the level of anti-security actions targeting these events.

Regardless, these concerns exist. Regarding the trial of the MEK, as was mentioned, we are following up on filing a lawsuit against the group in international forums to open a case there. Once these cases are officially opened abroad, we can use those legal proceedings to prevent their gatherings in places like France.

### Part of a classified audio document from the 18th session of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – August 28, 2024

The 18th session of the Security Council, dated August 28, 2024.

**Niabati:** Our first agenda item is the presentation and review of the most important news regarding specific events, which Mr. Sadat, the honorable Advisor to the Governor's Office and the General Security Representative, will present, God willing. With the blessing of a Salawat upon Muhammad and the progeny of Muhammad.

#### **Kamal Sadat, Director General of Security and Law Enforcement for Tehran Province:**

I seek refuge in Allah from Satan the outcast. In the name of Allah, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. Greetings once again to all the dear and honorable colleagues. My condolences for these [religious] days, and my appreciation and gratitude for the hard work of all the dear colleagues.

I shall present the highlights of the news and information to all the dear colleagues. As you can see on the PowerPoint in front of you, the security topics include:

Increased mobilization of the families of the deceased from the 1401 [2022] riots, centered on both physical and virtual spaces, on the eve of the anniversary of the riots.

The growth of movements by Resistance Units to plan the execution of 100 daily operations across the entire country.

Support from the MEK for the families of vulnerable social strata through monthly deposits of 10 to 15 million Tomans in the form of cryptocurrency.

Planning by the MEK to exploit the capacity of Afghan nationals by paying cryptocurrency for "fire-oriented operations", condemning the treatment of [Afghan] nationals, and other similar issues.

The detrimental movements of the families of those executed in the 1360s [1980s] at the Khavaran Cemetery on the eve of the anniversary of the burials of the deceased.

### Part of a secret audio transcript from the 21st session of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – October 1, 2024

21st Extraordinary Session of the Security Council, October 1 (10-7)

[Moderator]: Mr. Rastegar, please proceed.

#### **Rastegar, Head of the Tehran Intelligence Organization:**

In the name of God, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. Greetings. Currently, the MEK is active and has recently been dealt a blow. They are conducting launcher operations using these handmade "curved-fire" [improvised mortars/projectiles] that they implement and operate.

If we want to say they can be controlled physically—meaning via patrols—it is very difficult. It must be handled through intelligence methods because they can go, for example, onto a rooftop or into a courtyard; in short, their firing process takes only 2 to 5 minutes, after which they can hide themselves away in a basement or a room and remain undetected.

The last strike against them was carried out by our colleagues in the Tehran IRGC; it hasn't even been seven, eight, or ten days since we arrested a "launcher group." This group [the MEK] has the capacity and capability to mobilize its operational apparatus and bring teams from other provinces into Tehran. This

means that once the Friday Prayer is announced, they likely have the ability to summon several teams—one team, two teams—and tell them to go and station themselves there.

Around the Mosalla [Grand Prayer Site], there are residential buildings. Some of these residential units are listed on websites and apps for hourly or daily rental. They rent a house with minimal oversight and carry out their operations very easily. While we are occupied with other matters, these individuals can be very dangerous. Well, this is a threat that we must, God willing, pursue through intelligence-based methods and...

### **Part of a secret audio recording from the 22nd meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – October 7, 2024**

Moderator: We are convened for the twenty-second session of the Provincial Security Council. Very well, Dr. [Rastegar], the floor is yours.

#### **Rastegar, Head of the Tehran Intelligence Organization:**

In the name of God, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. I should inform you that the MEK contact has organized what they call Resistance Units to be on standby.

Firstly, they are to attend gatherings and play a leadership role. Secondly, they are instructed to maintain supplies of gasoline and waste oil for making Molotov cocktails, and each individual should be able to carry personal [tactical] equipment.

I have prepared this list in writing, and it will be provided to our dear brothers [colleagues]. They have a plan for how to exploit the atmosphere and pursue their objectives should the city fall into chaos. They have announced approximately nine items—nine clauses—to be disseminated. Regarding this "Mosalla" [Grand Prayer Grounds] case, Mr. Nayibi previously mentioned...

### **Part of a Secret Audio Document from the 25th Meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – November 4, 2024**

With the permission of the honorable Governor and the honorable Chairman of the Security Council, we are holding the 25th meeting of the Security Council for the current year, and the first meeting in the presence of the new Governor. Dr. Rastegar, the floor is yours.

#### **Rastegar, Head of the Tehran Intelligence Organization:**

In the name of God, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. Some small groups, such as the MEK, have stepped even further. Currently, the MEK has prepared 16 video clips, each 5 to 10 minutes long, where each clip specifically demonstrates a particular subject. That is, they are providing visual training. Some of the titles of these clips include:

Methods of organization; how to design an offensive operation; how to identify a target; operational plans such as seizing bases and police stations; attacking patrols; how to confront motorcycle units; urban warfare using hit-and-run tactics; surprise attacks; and other matters. I will provide a report on these to you, dear colleagues, and I will also present the clips themselves to you. Well, they have prepared themselves for "that moment."

### **Part of a Secret Audio Document from the 29th Meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – December 17, 2024**

With the permission of the honorable Governor, we are holding the 29th meeting of the Security Council. We are at your service, Professor [Doctor]:

#### **Rastegar, Head of the Tehran Intelligence Organization:**

Regarding the MEK's agenda: right now, they have two safe houses in Tehran. They have issued a call and, unfortunately, mentioned weapons—"with weapons." They are procuring arms. I don't know if they

intend to carry out assassinations or what they plan to do. However, we hadn't seen weapon procurement [from them] previously. Now, when we monitor them, we see that all of them have weapons; they have come here and are essentially organizing and planning their next actions in these safe houses. Thank God, we are currently "on top" of these two [houses/cells], but we do not know if more than these two exist or not.

## Part of the secret audio transcript from the 30th meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council-December 30, 2024

30th Meeting of the Security Council – 12/30/2024

Mr. Rastegar, Bismillah [please proceed].

### **Rastegar, Head of the Tehran Intelligence Organization:**

Greetings to the honorable Generals. At the beginning of my remarks, I would also like to congratulate those dear colleagues who have recently been entrusted—either reappointed or for the first time—with responsibilities in Tehran Province.

Regarding security intelligence, we continue to witness the focus of the MEK on conducting operations in Tehran and some of the new methods they are adopting. As of now, following their call [for action], they have brought several operational teams from provincial elements into Tehran and stationed them in safe houses where they are currently undergoing training.

One new development was training for the construction of magnetic bombs [sticky bombs]. Magnetic bombs are typically used only by [foreign] services or elements affiliated with those services. We are looking into what plans they have for these magnetic bombs; fortunately, we have intelligence dominance and are currently monitoring them to see what their plan is.

They are also working on another new initiative. If you recall, for a period, they turned to quadcopters to carry out propaganda activities in high-traffic areas like the Bazaar—meaning they would fly them over the crowds and distribute leaflets and proclamations. At that time—since we had intelligence oversight—both our units and other agencies (I believe the IRGC as well) had eyes on it, and we dealt with it effectively, and it was removed from their agenda.

Now, they are testing "remote projectiles." The projectile works in such a way that these propaganda items are launched, go up, and are then detonated via remote control to scatter the materials. They are currently testing this; they have conducted two tests around the outskirts of Tehran, but their tests failed. They are now following up and identifying the defects so they can pursue this further. We hope to deal with this in the same way we did the quadcopter issue, so that it is removed from their agenda as well.

## Part of a Secret Audio Document from the 31st Meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council- January 13, 2025

### **...Tehran Intelligence Organization:**

In the name of God, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. We seek His help. Peace be upon you and good day. I would like to offer my congratulations in advance on the birth anniversary of Imam Ali (AS) to all the esteemed individuals present in the meeting. I will briefly present a few reports and then I will be at your service.

Regarding the use of the "Delta Chat" software by the MEK, we are aware that they are somehow working with their handlers through this platform. This software is, in a way, "de facto" encrypted; all its messages pass through because it has no specific server and practically nothing is stored anywhere, making it fully usable in this environment. They have designated this path for communication between their elements and their handlers—specifically the Delta Chat software.

We have received reports regarding a plan dubbed "The Conquest of Tehran" (Fath-e-Tehran). In truth, they have targeted certain areas of Tehran for the organization of "neighborhood-oriented cells." Their objectives include inciting riots at government and security centers and the seizure of key institutions.

They are working on the issue of disarmament—specifically how to disarm military barracks and, in particular, police stations—which I believe must be taken into consideration. They also have a special focus on District 11 of Tehran. Furthermore, please be informed that the latest status is that we have heard 100 elements of the MEK are set to enter the country via West Azerbaijan under the guise of tourists to lead and direct the ongoing riots. I am at your service.

**Motamedian, Governor of Tehran:**



Friends are aware—and surely Aqa Seyyed will also mention this when it is his turn—regarding the annual gathering held by the MEK. Mr. Keith Kellogg, who is Mr. Trump's special representative regarding Ukraine and such matters, participates in that meeting and delivers a speech. He raises the issue of "organized resistance" for the future of the Islamic Republic alongside the people. This could essentially serve as a prelude to a reconnection of the MEK to issues related to riots and the plans they envision for the future.

### **Part of a secret audio transcript from the 35th meeting of the Tehran Province Security Council – March 3, 2025**

35th Meeting of the Security Council – March 3, 2025

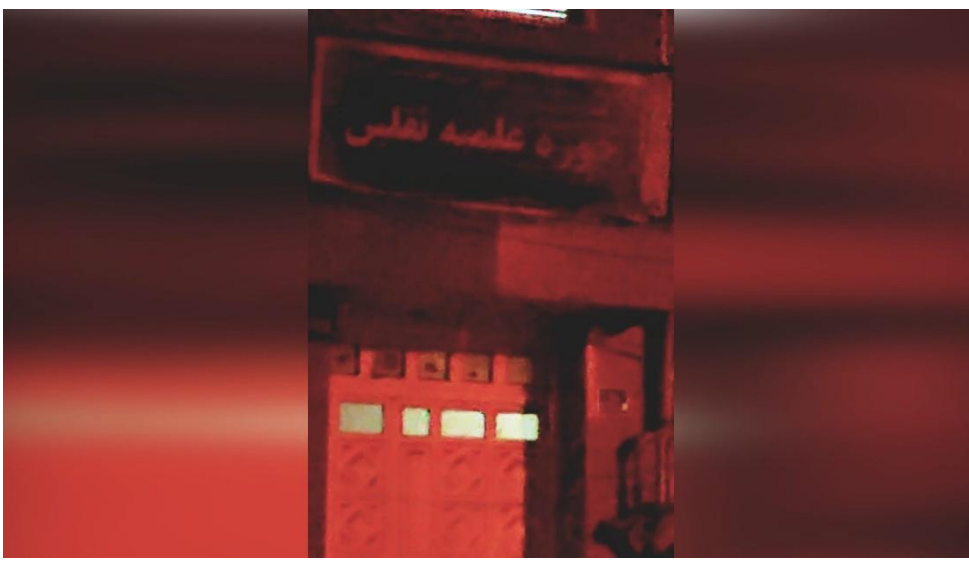
Chairman: General Tavakkoli, if there is anything to report, please proceed.

**Tavakkoli (Tehran IRGC Intelligence):**

In the name of Allah, the Beneficent, the Merciful. I have two news items and one report to present. Based on the assessments conducted by our brothers in the Tehran IRGC Intelligence, we recorded over 1,050 instances of slogan-writing [graffiti] across Tehran during the month of Dey [Dec/Jan], which shows an increase compared to previous periods. Most of these were erased by Basij forces.

In the month of Bahman [Jan/Feb], this figure increased by 50%, reaching 1,560 cases, most of which were again erased by the Basij boys. Regarding attacks on locations, the situation is similar. In the month of Dey, we had one reported attack on the Imam Hossein (AS) Seminary; however, in Bahman, this increased to six cases. Some of these were Basij resistance bases, two were banks, and one was a municipality building in District 2. These were mainly attacked using improvised explosive devices by agents of the MEK. In the month of Esfand [Feb/March], this trend has continued over the past 11 or 12 days, including an attack on a resistance base in District 4, the Saqalayn Seminary, and a female Basij base in District 14, using incendiary materials and handmade grenades.





**Amir Abdollahian (Coordination Deputy of the IRGC Seyyed al-Shohada, Tehran Province):**

Peace be upon you. Greetings and respect to all colleagues, and I wish for your prayers and fasting to be accepted. As mentioned, disruptive actions, slogan-writing, and attacks on Basij bases and districts have also increased across the counties of Tehran province. Thankfully, in two instances in Qarchak, we arrested two individuals who were members of Resistance Units and were burning banners. One person was also arrested in Pardis. Additionally, we had two threats against military sites; one in Shahr-e-Rey where a base was hit with a Molotov cocktail, and in our Pishva district, someone came and made threats.

**Chairman:** Dr. Rastegar, we are at your service.

**Rastegar (Head of the Tehran Intelligence Organization):**

In the name of Allah, the Beneficent, the Merciful. From January 17 to February 9—a 30-day period—we had 25 explosive disruptive actions in Tehran and 23 propaganda actions by the MEK. To put this in perspective, in terms of explosive disruptive actions, Khorasan Razavi province ranks second with 13 cases. This means we [Tehran] are at double the national average in this field.

Fortunately, we have gained good intelligence access. We have identified about 60 to 70 of these individuals who are part of Resistance Units. Depending on our workload, we intend to deal with them either before or after the [Nowruz] New Year to ensure this situation is somewhat managed. Their attacks are currently focused mostly on the buildings of the Foundation of Martyrs [Bonyad-e Shahid]; recently, they have been paying a lot of attention to the Foundation of Martyrs' buildings and are targeting them.

**Excerpt from a Secret Audio Document of the 36th Session of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – March 17, 2024**

Opening Remarks:

"Well, with your permission, and in the presence of the honorable Governor and Chairman of the Security Council, we begin the 36th session of the Security Council, held as a regular meeting. The first item on the agenda is the presentation and review of the latest news and events, compiled by our colleagues in the News Committee, to be presented by Mr. Sadat. [Opening] with a blessing upon Muhammad and his progeny."

**Kamal Sadat (Director General of Security and Law Enforcement, Tehran Governor's Office):**

"I will present the threats and risks associated with the 'Last Wednesday of the Year' [Chaharshanbe Suri]. We are seeing an intensification of activity by Resistance Units involving the throwing of Molotov cocktails and hand grenades at sovereign and government sites, Hussainiyas, and religious delegations, as well as at officers, emergency vehicles, fire trucks, unoccupied private vehicles, and others. This includes the destruction and burning of national and religious banners, monuments, CCTV surveillance cameras, billboards, and traffic signs.

[We are also seeing] the use of quadcopters and drones to drop explosives into power plant infrastructure, or military, law enforcement, religious, government, and diplomatic sites, among others; the use of firearms and shooting with the aim of demonstrating power and intimidating citizens; and graffiti writing, the distribution of leaflets, shouting slogans from rooftops, or launching balloons containing anti-revolutionary messages."

### **Excerpt from a Secret Audio Document of the 1st Session of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – April 11, 2025**

**Dr. Nayebi (Deputy for Security and Law Enforcement and Secretary of the Tehran Provincial Security Council):**

"In the name of God, and with the permission of the honorable Chairman. We are at your service for the first Security Council meeting of the New Year. According to the agenda, we have the news presentation and the review of the most important events, which Mr. Sadat, the honorable Director General, will present, God willing. We are at your service."

**Seyyed Kamal Sadat (Director General of Security, Tehran Governor's Office):**

"The 'No to Execution Tuesdays' campaign, featuring families of death row inmates, continues in limited numbers in front of Evin Prison, accompanied by photos of the convicts and 'No to Execution' banners.

[There are] calls from the MEK regarding the intensification of fire-based [arson] operations, centered on solo operations. These are characterized by a focus on revolutionary and Islamic sites—especially seminaries—individuals acting alone while using their mobile phones for documentation, wearing black clothing, focusing on movement by foot to carry out operations, and the use of gasoline. Additionally, the intensification of harassment actions by the MEK since the beginning of the year has included the burning of billboards, images of the Leadership, tires, and trash cans."

### **Part of a Secret Audio Document: 7th Meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – June 2, 2025**

**Kamal Sadat (Director General of Security, Tehran Governorate):**

With the permission of the honorable Governor, Mr. Dr. Motamedian, we shall begin—God willing—the seventh meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council for the year 1404.

**Kamal Sadat (Director General of Security, Tehran Governorate):**

You are observing the latest security and law enforcement developments: a call by the MEK to carry out terrorist actions against national officials, as well as the acquisition of tickets for the Iran vs. North Korea match on Tuesday, June 10th, at Azadi Stadium for unknown reasons. It is unclear why they have issued this call. Furthermore, Maryam Rajavi stated in her latest speech: "The pent-up rage of the Iranian people is being activated through the leadership of the Resistance Units."

### **Part of a Secret Audio Document: 11th Meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – June 30, 2025**

**Dr. Nayebi (Deputy for Security and Law Enforcement and Secretary of the Tehran Provincial Security Council):**

We are at your service for this extraordinary session per the Governor's instructions. First, we will hear from Mr. Agha-Seyyed; Mr. A-Seyyed Mohammad, please provide the latest information and news, and then we will be at your service regarding the measures that must be taken.

**Seyyed Mohammad (Deputy of the Tehran Intelligence Organization - Ministry of Intelligence):**

Regarding the MEK, they have an issue with the [Israeli] regime's warmongering approach and do not accept it. Maryam Rajavi has stated in her remarks that we must adopt a "Third Way": neither war nor appeasement. She also believes the people must take to the streets and that the overthrow of the system must occur through internal chaos. On the other hand, the newly emerged groups are fully at the service of the [Israeli] regime, particularly the faction closely aligned with the Monarchists.

The important point currently is that the actions of Reza Pahlavi and the Monarchists in supporting the [Israeli] regime's military operations and declaring their readiness to be present in Iran have created a severe rift within the opposition. If we can appreciate and maintain this internal cohesion—which has been established by the grace of God and the blessing of the martyrs' blood—no unity will form among the opposition for a long time; this will assist us and they will be relegated to obscurity. We must keep this perspective in mind to exploit the current atmosphere.

**Part of a Secret Audio Document: 12th Meeting of the Tehran Provincial Security Council – July 14, 2025**

**Dr. Nayebi (Deputy for Security and Law Enforcement and Secretary of the Tehran Provincial Security Council):**

Very well. I offer my respects to the honorable Governor and the honorable Head of the Security Council. We are at your service for the twelfth meeting of the Security Council for the year 1404 in an ordinary session. The first item on the agenda is the presentation and review of the most important news, events, and assessments, which Mr. Sadat, the honorable Director General of Security, will present to you; with a salutation upon Muhammad and his progeny.

**Kamal Sadat (Director General of Security, Tehran Governorate):**

Propaganda regarding prisoners transferred from Evin Prison and the presence of certain families and "problematic individuals" in front of the Greater Tehran Prison is being pursued intensely. Hostile media outlets are providing extensive coverage of the [Zionist] regime's attack on the prison and the transfer of prisoners to poor conditions, attempting to call the prisons into question

The MEK continues to operate extensively against the country. Their latest strategy dictates the use of basic Nokia SIM cards, one-way calls from abroad, chatting via email, and the use of the Zangi and Delta Chat applications, as well as Starlink satellites. The direction of the MEK during the 12-day war emphasized non-interference in that matter; therefore, preparation for "Hour Zero" is also on this cult's agenda. Furthermore, field actions to rename streets using offensive keywords are being promoted by the MEK, and there is a possibility of this intensifying.
